

Food Bank

With the establishment of a food bank in Heraklion, Crete, the network now numbers six. We coordinate our actions, support each other, and help even more people, covering a large part of Greece. We will continue our efforts to help organise new food banks.

In 2022, the network distributed 2,172 tons of products helping more than 112,000 people. In total, it supported 324 soup kitchens and institutions, while 182 companies entrusted us with their products. The Athens Food Bank distributed 1,577 tons, compared to 1,644 in 2021. The Thessaloniki Food Bank saw an increase, with 433 tons in 2022, compared to 405 in 2021.

The 'Emergency Food Fund' project we launched in 2020, with targeted purchase and distribution of foods, is very successful. The detailed results are presented in the following pages. Special thanks go to the Andreas Mentzelopoulos Foundation, The Hellenic Initiative, TIMA Charitable Foundation and MYTILINEOS S.A., for supporting it through their donations. I especially want to note the support of the Sani | Ikos Group, which enabled us to send 55 tons of foodstuffs for the needs of Ukrainians, through the Romanian Food Bank.

The fight against the impact of climate change is creating a new and more expanded role for Food Banks. The destruction of food by burying it in landfills, or by other methods, is responsible for a significant share of

generated greenhouse gases. The European Union and individual countries, have begun to adopt legislation aiming to limit the destruction of surplus food not commercially viable. Food Banks play a crucial role in this process. In some European countries, manufacturers and distribution chains have entered into agreements with Food Banks for long-term cooperation. Sooner or later, such measures will be adopted in Greece as well.













In June 2022, the Food Bank published the results of its survey, **'Food needs in the general population 2'.**

This publication presents the data we have gathered on food insecurity and, at the same time, expresses our concerns for the future.

According to Eurostat, 12.4% of Greece's population was experiencing food insecurity in 2020. We can safely conclude from the remaining data that this percentage has clearly increased, without, however, being able to assess this increase in numerical terms.






















Individual programs, with different sponsors and specific results, are implemented under the **Emergency Food Fund** umbrella.


From the middle of 2022 and until June 2023, the Food Bank supports by food purchases, 25% of the food needs for 8 selected non-profit nursing homes in Attica.

The Paul and Alexandra Canellopoulos Foundation is providing support for the establishment of new food banks in Epirus and Crete

5,293 kg of products have been already distributed and the program will be continued until the middle of 2023.









With the support of the Sani | Ikos Group, 55 tons of food were sent to Romania for the needs of Ukrainian refugees, while part of this amount was also able to get into Ukraine.

The Romanian Food Bank has served hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian refugees since the early days of the war. Right now, about 9,000 Ukrainians are receiving its assistance, though food donations continually dwindle.

Support from FEBA covered the cost of shipping the products. Additionally, we also visited refugees facilities in Bucharest in person. Schools have been converted to camps, while families with young children wait patiently, asking for assistance.







Moreover, 22 tons of essential products were shipped to Bucharest after additional company donations.







Drama Food Bank







- 8.7 tons of vegetables in cooperation with producers at the Drama farmers' market.
- 6.2 tons of bread and bakery products in cooperation with local shops.
- 'The Collection Boxes of Love' in cooperation with a total of 21 local shops to support the Food Bank of the Ladies Union of Drama-House of Open Hospitality.

Epirus Food Bank



The Epirus Food Bank was established on initiative of Konstantinos Papageorgiou and is now in operation.

With the generous support of PTL LLP transport and logistics company, it maintains a warehouse in Arta and Ioannina, and since March 2022, has provided free food to soup kitchens and institutions in Epirus.









Food Bank of Crete



The Food Bank of Crete opened its doors in May 2022 under the auspices of the Association of Members of Women's Associations of Heraklion.

In its first few months of operation, it had already donated 16 tons of products to 4,000 people in Heraklion.
